

Advent United Methodist Volunteer Covenant

The Congregation of Advent United Methodist Church is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all children, youth, vulnerable adults and volunteers who participate in ministries and activities sponsored by the church. The following policy statements reflect our congregation's commitment to preserving this church as a holy place of safety and protection for all who would enter and as a place in which all people can experience the love of God through relationships with others.

1. No adult who has been convicted of child abuse (either sexual abuse, physical abuse, or emotional abuse) should volunteer to work with children or youth in any church-sponsored activity.
2. All adult volunteers involved with children or youth of our church must have attended regularly or have been members of the congregation for at least six months before beginning a volunteer assignment.
3. Adult volunteers shall observe the "Two Adult Rule, at all times so that no adult is ever alone with children or youth.
4. Adult volunteers shall immediately report to the senior pastor or pastor on call any behavior that seems abusive or inappropriate.
5. Adult volunteers agree to attend training and educational events provided by the church to keep volunteers informed of church policies.
